The next word in our vocabulary boost series is WRITE. WRITE is a high frequency verb that can be used as a synonym of *take notes, discard, redact*. There are numerous collocations and phrasal verbs that are formed using WRITE.

Phrasal verbs:

The learning of phrasal verbs is best done using this method ([HERE](#))

Write off – discard

I had to write off the job offer as I didn't have the means of transport to make the long commute

Write out – write in full

I was sick of my job so I decided to write out my resignation letter

Write down – take notes

In class I always write down everything the teacher say of interest

Write back – answer someone in written format

I decided to write back to my pen pal to explain what was going on

Write in – add a name to a list

Can you write me in for the course on Saturday?

Write into – add a specific detail

I wrote the new information into the minutes (notes) of the meeting
